

Step-By-Step Instructions

Warning:

- This product is for towing purposes only and must only be loaded as shown in your vehicle Owner's Manual.
- This towbar is NOT to be drilled, cut, welded, or modified in any way.
- Check behind chassis rail and body panels before drilling to ensure no hazards are present
- All load ratings shown are under the assumption your trailer has a functional braking system installed
- When installed in positions other than the one depicted in these instructions the Tow Ball Mount may interfere or obstruct certain features of your vehicle (tailgate opening, Chassis clearance, etc.)

General:

- Before fitting this towbar read fitting instructions and check installation hardware is correct.
- Check that the towbar is suitable for the vehicle and be wary of any changes to the vehicle design that may conflict with the fitting of this towbar. (Tray, Canopy, Suspension etc.)
- After drilling, blow any filings clear, remove any swarf and treat exposed metal with a rust inhibitor.
- The high tensile fasteners supplied with this product are an integral feature to achieving the specified rating, if replacement is required ensure that fasteners of the same grade (8.8) & quality are used. Contact an authorised TAG distributer or the TAG fitment centre (07) 3208 3022 if further information is required.

Towbar Maintenance and Care:

It is recommended, when not in use, the Tow Ball Mount assembly and class 4 Pin and Clip is stored inside the car away from moisture to prevent standing water from forming rust. Inspect to ensure, on regular basis, fasteners are torqued to the specifications below and in good condition.

Ensure that the fitting instructions are read and understood prior to fitment Place these instructions in the vehicle's glovebox after installation is completed



Step 1. Fit Towbar

- a) Lay out the fitting kit next to the towbar with the fasteners in their respective positions on the towbar and ensure all hardware to be included is in the kit and correct
- b) Mate endplates to chassis and loosely secure with 4 X M12 x 1.25 x 45 Bolts and washers, 3 on the side and one on the inside of the chassis in the forward most hole on the bottom face, the rear most hole receives the bolt on plate with wire in the same orientation. Both bottom bolts are complete with the respective washers and nuts
- c) Repeat for the other side
- d) Loosely secure the crossmember (Welded Assembly) to the endplates with 8 X M12 x 1.25 x 45 and two washers followed by a nut.

NOTE: If a gap larger than 3mm on either side is present use the included Packer plates between the centre assembly and endplate assemblies.

e) Starting with the endplates torque all fasteners to the respective specifications included in the table.

Step 2. Apply Door Sticker

 Apply one of the compliance labels to the pillar of the driver's door. Leave the remaining label & the fitting instructions in the vehicle handbook.
